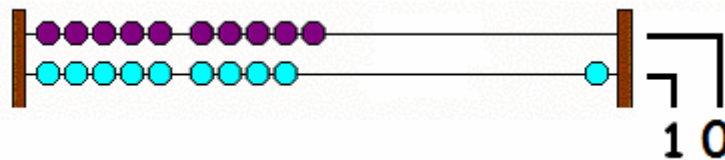


## WRITING THE COUNT

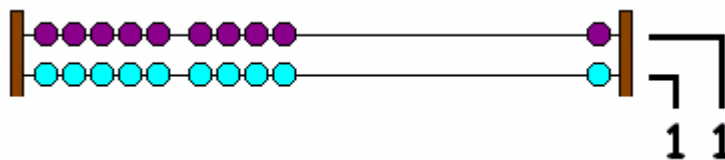
**FACT 1:** Digits are used to write the counts. There are only ten digits as follows.

0	ZERO	_____
1	ONE	_____●
2	TWO	_____●●
3	THREE	_____●●●
4	FOUR	_____●●●●
5	FIVE	_____●●●●●
6	SIX	_____●●●●●●
7	SEVEN	_____●●●●●●●
8	EIGHT	_____●●●●●●●●
9	NINE	_____●●●●●●●●●

**FACT 2:** There is no new digit needed to write TEN, because ten is written with two digits as follows.



**FACT 3:** Each wire has its own digit showing how many beads are on that wire. The count of eleven is written as follows.



1. Count and write the single-digit number from zero to nine.
2. Count and write the double-digit numbers from ten to nineteen.
